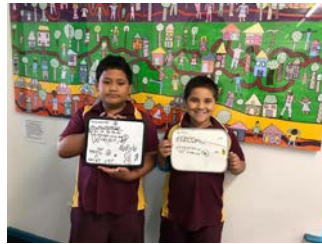

**HOW MUCH SCREEN TIME EVERYDAY?**

0-2 years	NO screen time	Increase active play and limit sedentary activities to less than 1 hour at a time
2-5 years	Less than 1 HOUR per day	A reduction in screen time can improve sleep patterns and physical development
5-12 years	Less than 2 HOURS per day	Excluding homework time

## DRIVING OFFENCES IN SCHOOL ZONES

With your help, a safer community.

**Disobey 'No Parking' Sign**  
 DROP OFF & PICK-UP ONLY  
 8 AM - 9:30 AM  
 2:30 - 4 PM  
 SCHOOL DAYS  
 Fine = \$183 & Lose 2 Points  
 'KISS & DROP' ZONE  
 ONLY stop to drop off or pick up  
 Stay within 3 meters of your car  
 Stay less than 2 minutes

**Disobey 'No Stopping' Sign**  
 NO STOPPING  
 DO NOT STOP for ANY reason  
 Fine = \$330 & Lose 2 Points

**Child or Passenger Not Restrained**  
 Fine = \$330 & Lose 3 Points

**Driver Uses Mobile Phone When Not Allowed by Law**  
 Fine = \$439 & Lose 4 Points
