Attendance including COVID Advice –

It is with great pleasure that I announce 98% of our students have returned back to face-to-face teaching.

Please ensure that if your child experiences any flu-like symptoms (even if they are mild) that they stay home to rest and recover. If your child is absent please send a medical note or alternatively a letter stating the reason for their absence.

The school will continually work with the department who is constantly working with NSW Health to provide us with advice and guidance on maintaining safe hygiene practices.

So far the advice and school procedures include:

- Masks are required to be worn on school site by staff and strongly recommended for Stage 3 students.
- Antibacterial sanitizer and wipes are used frequently and students are reminded to wash their hands regularly.
- Having open or well-ventilated spaces reduces the risk of transmission of COVID-19 because infectious particles are more quickly diffused in the open air, so classrooms are receiving good ventilation by ensuring windows and doors are open.
- Support teachers are not mixing across the grades. The school has aligned teachers to a grade to minimise potential spread.
- Stages are segregated during break times; meaning less students in one area and students are playing with the students in their class.
- K- 2 has an early departure of 2:50pm at Norfolk Rd gate and 3-6 finish at 3pm exiting from both Waterloo Rd and David St.

The school is following the advice closely to maintain safety at the school.
