


<u>Naplan Testing</u> Ms. Amara Issa & Ms. Souha Malek

NAPLAN Online, for years 3 and 5 students, commences on Tuesday 10th May and ends on Friday 20th May. The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual assessment for all students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. These tests assess the type of skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life. The skills that will be covered include reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation, and numeracy.

The public demonstration site offers demonstration tests covering a sample of possible questions and do not reflect the range of literacy and numeracy content or skills NAPLAN Online will assess.
